Approve Resolution No. 18-2020-2021 Teacher Appreciation Week and California Day of the Teacher, May 3-7, 2021

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In 1982, the Day of the Teacher became an annual California celebration. The California Education Code 37337.6 states:

"All public schools and educational institutions shall observe this day with suitable exercises commemorating and directing attention to teachers and the teaching profession." In 1985, the second Tuesday in May was designated for the annual observance of California's "Day of the Teacher." This year, Tuesday, May 4, 2021, has been designated as "California's Day of the Teacher" and May 3-7, 2021 as "Teacher Appreciation Week."

National Teacher Appreciation Day, also known as National Teacher Day, is observed on the Tuesday of the first full week in May. This day is part of Teacher Appreciation week, which is the first full week in May of each year.
