BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The proposed new High School course Visual and Performing Arts - Music will allow the students to develop various technological skills associated with careers in the music industry. Students will progress through units centered on an introduction to music production hardware, sequencing and looping, compositional technique, MIDI, recording live sound, editing, mixing and mastering, and the music technology business.

The course will be offered to students in grade levels 9 - 12 and is a one-year course. Five credits per semester will be earned. There are no prerequisites to take this course.
