Information Only - First Read of Proposed New High School Sports Medicine Course 2 for 2023-2024. Review and provide direction on course adoption.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sports Medicine Course 2 is designed for students to apply the fundamentals of concepts learned in sports medicine course 1. Students will learn advanced skills for understanding anatomy, kinesiology, prevention, evaluation, treatment, and rehabilitation of illness, disease, and injury. Career Ready Practice Standards are integrated throughout the course allowing students to develop their problem-solving, collaboration, communication, and critical thinking skills through scenario evaluation and project-based learning experiences.

This course is for Grades 10 - 12 and is a one-year course. There are five credits per semester or ten credits for the year. The prerequisite for this course is Sports Medicine Course 1.
