Approve Nevada County Wellness Services Contract for 2022-23

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The TTUSD Wellness Program is a collaborative project between the school district, Nevada and Placer Counties, the Community Collaborative of Tahoe Truckee partners and youth designed to help middle and high school students access a broad spectrum of mental health services. The scope of work includes Wellness Centers at Truckee High, North Tahoe High, North Tahoe Middle School, Alder Creek Middle School, and individualized wellness programming at Sierra High and the TTUSD Community School. The staff includes a Wellness Manager, Kim Bradley, and four Wellness Liaisons. The program is directly supervised by site administrators and is supported by the Student Services Department.

We are entering into our tenth year of this co-funded program and Nevada County is set to contribute \$120,704 for the 2022-2023 school year. The TTUSD Wellness Program has grown over the last eight years and the centers and the programs that they provide are firmly embedded in the school culture. Wellness staff work directly with youth to educate and empower them to have a voice in decisions about their own health and well-being. The program offers students the opportunity to develop personal resiliency, peer support, and leadership skills while connecting youth with caring adults and peers. The Wellness staff collaborates with our school counselors and school psychologists to provide a seamless system of care for all students.
