

Two Laws Supporting Transgender Youth

AB 1266 (Feb 2013) Pupil rights: sex-segregated school programs and activities.

"A pupil shall be permitted to participate in sex-segregated school programs and activities, including athletic teams and competitions, and use facilities consistent with his or her gender identity, irrespective of the gender listed on the pupil's records."

So What?

We need a solution so that all students, regardless of transgender status/gender identity can have a safe and accessible bathroom.



AB 1732 (March 2017) Single-user restrooms

- AB 1732 Health & Safety Code 118600(a)
 - "All single-user toilet facilities in any business establishment, place of public accommodation, or state or local government agency shall be identified as all-gender toilet facilities by signage that complies with Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations, and designated for use by no more than one occupant at a time or for family or assisted use.
 - Available to **students** desiring increased privacy regardless of underlying reason
 - Voluntary, at request of student, maintain confidentiality
 - No undue burden on student
 - Consider: no key, location

How the board can help?

I'm asking that the district unlock all single stall bathrooms to make them accessible to students in accordance with the law.









What would it take? mean?

Unlock the single stall bathrooms

In a few cases, remove the signs that say STAFF RESTROOM and replace with gender-neutral signage that complies with the law.

What would it

Decreased gender dysphoria for trans students

Increased learning time (up to 5:00+ for each trip)

Confidentiality for all genderexpansive students

Counter Argument

- Students could lock themselves in
- Teachers need a location to use the restroom
- More to clean

Be on the Right Side of History

Rhode Island, Oregon, Chicago, Denver, and Philadelphia's school boards have converted single-stall restrooms within their schools to accessible all-gender restrooms for students.

"State schools Superintendent Tony Thurmond announced (November 2021) the formation of a committee to make recommendations to expand the availability of gender neutral bathrooms on California school campuses."
