BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Truckee Tahoe Airport Board requests the TTUSD Board to discuss and vote to support Aim High's partnership application. The AIM High application with the Truckee Tahoe Airport District will only be considered when endorsed through a formal motion or resolution by the governing board of another local public agency with an elected or appointed board.

Aim High is a five-week summer enrichment program for rising 6th – 9th graders from low-income communities. The program is offered at no cost to students and their families and typically serves about 100-125 Tahoe-Truckee students. Aim High helps middle schoolers build academic confidence, discover a love of learning, and develop the skills they need to thrive in high school and life.
