ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the 2021-2022 Comprehensive School Safety Plans.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

California *Education Code (EC)* Section 32281(a) requires every kindergarten through grade twelve public school to develop and maintain a Comprehensive School Safety Plan (CSSP) designed to address campus risks, prepare for emergencies, and create a safe, secure learning environment for students and school personnel.

CSSPs include, but are not limited to, strategies and policies to prevent and respond to potential incidents involving emergencies, natural and other disasters, hate crimes, violence, active assailants/intruders, bullying and cyberbullying, discrimination and harassment, child abuse and neglect, discipline, suspension and expulsion, and other safety aspects. These plans were developed, sent to local law enforcement and fire agencies for review and feedback, and approved at a public School Site Council meeting.
