## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The policy was updated to reference NEW LAW (SB 114, 2023). In the event the district would not offer any state-required program, a waiver would have to go to the TTUSD Board of Education. If approved, it would then go to the State Board of Education for final approval. Policy also updated to provide that advertisement of the notice for the public hearing, which is required before the Governing Board submitting a waiver request to the State Board of Education includes publishing it on the district's website.
