BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) is a comprehensive document providing details about the school's planned actions and expenditures to support student outcomes and overall performance, and how these actions connect to the District's Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP), which lays out goals for the entire District.

Also, as part of the SPSAs, all Title I school-wide programs are required to develop a comprehensive plan, with the involvement of parents and other members of the community. The Title I plan is regularly monitored and revised as necessary based on student needs and shall include descriptions of strategies that the school will be implementing to address school needs. Title I Schools are Kings Beach Elementary, Tahoe Lake Elementary, North Tahoe Middle School, North Tahoe High School, Truckee Elementary School, and Sierra High School.
