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### **ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve the School Accountability Report Cards (SARC) for 2021- 2022.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

In November 1988, California voters passed [Proposition 98](#), also known as *The Classroom Instructional Improvement and Accountability Act*. This ballot initiative provides California's public schools with a stable funding source.

In return, all public schools in California are required annually to prepare School Accountability Report Cards (SARCs) and disseminate them to the public. SARCs are intended to provide the public with important information about each public school and communicate its progress in achieving its goals.

Please note that the data in these four sections of the 2021-2022 SARC have yet to be released due to a delay from the CDE.

- 1) 21-22 Teacher Preparation and Placement
- 2) 21-22 Teachers without Credentials and Misassignments
- 3) 21-22 Credentialed Teachers Assigned Out-of-Field
- 4) 21-22 Class Assignments

A revised copy of the SARC will be available once the data has been released.
