## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD) partners with the Placer County Office of Education (PCOE) to collaborate on implementing and sustaining improvement efforts for our English Learners.

Differentiated assistance is a type of support provided to districts when the district fails to improve pupil achievement across multiple state priorities for one or more student groups. For TTUSD, we receive differentiated assistance support because our English Learners need to progress more in the priority areas of Graduation Rate and College Career Indicators. Because assistance isn't a "one size fits all" solution, TTUSD and PCOE have met with the school leaders, ELD teachers, and other support staff to develop an improvement plan to support better outcomes for our English Learners.
