


Facility Master Plan



The Facility Master Plan (FMP)

- "Living" document
- Essential tool for a district's planning process to meet its strategic goals
- The Facilities Master Plan <u>brings the community, students,</u> staff, and stakeholders together in one coordinated vision

Policy 7110

 The master plan shall be regularly reviewed and updated as necessary to reflect changes in the educational program, existing facilities, finances, or demographic data
