Approve Resolution No. 23-2024-2025 - Forest Health and Wildfire Mitigation.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Tahoe Truckee Unified School District advocates for continued federal funding for our region.

This resolution supports opposing federal funding and staffing cuts to agencies like the U.S. Forest Service, the Bureau of Land Management, and the Army Corps of Engineers. These cuts negatively impact forest health and wildfire mitigation, increasing the risk of catastrophic fires in the district. The resolution highlights the potential for missed school days due to wildfire-related factors, such as poor air quality, active fires, evacuations, and power outages, which disrupt education. The district urges federal representatives to restore funding and staffing to these agencies to mitigate wildfire risks and ensure the continuity of education.
