Sagehen Outdoor Education Program is requesting funding for our 2025-2026 program. This program runs from August 2025-June 2026. Please note that our grant requests are made a full year ahead because the grant cycle and the school year does not coincide. We are requesting \$14,000. The annual operating budget for 2025-2026 is approximately \$40,000. This grant application is under the categories of Education and Youth Development. The funding that has been provided by Martis Camp Foundation in previous years is integral to the program's success.

Sagehen Outdoor Education Program is a program within the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District and is organized by the volunteer efforts of two retired fifth grade teachers. It has been providing engaging environmental science and outdoor education to all fifth-grade students in the Tahoe Truckee Schools for over 15 years. This program aims to instill a greater appreciation of nature, science, and the local environment. An established goal of environmental education is that the students will want to take care of their environment once they have grown to love it.

Lessons are activity-based and include team building, local ecosystems, flora and fauna of the local area, and other science/environmental education topics. Each class will attend 2 one-day programs in the fall (September-October), a one-day snow science program in the winter (February-March), and a one-day program in the spring (May-June). If funding allows and other educational activities are available, additional programing might be added. The activities and lessons are taught in a natural outdoor setting appropriate to each school's location. We are pleased to have most of the schools return to the program's original location at the UC Berkeley Sagehen Creek Field Station for instruction in the fall and the spring. Classes are taught by educators from two local non-profits: Sierra Watershed Education Partnerships (SWEP) and Tahoe Institute of Science (TINS).

Written evaluation of the program is done by students and teachers, and a yearly evaluation is done by program directors and school administrators.
