Presentation of the Instructional Leadership Team Improvement Cycle Process

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Our District Instructional Leadership Team (DILT) Professional learning Community(PLC) will complete three improvement cycles using state and district-wide local assessments. Following DILT PLC's Site Professional Learning Communities will also complete three improvement cycles using state and district-wide local assessments. The district and site level work will be guided by four questions: (1) What do we want our students to know? (Priority Standards), (2) How do we know if our students know it? (District Assessment Calendar), (3) What do we do if students do not know it? (PLC), and (4) What do we do if students do know it? (PLC)

Our district and site improvement cycles are connected to and support goals in the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) and School Plans for Student Achievement(SPSA). Site implementation of these cycles will also be aligned with principal evaluations.

The purpose of this work and the accompanying data analysis is to improve student learning outcomes for each TTUSD student for 2021-2022 and beyond. We will utilize state and district-wide local assessment data to frequently and consistently monitor the impact of our instructional practices. This information will guide the identification of research-based instructional changes to improve teaching and student learning to ensure that *Each TTUSD Graduate is College, Career, and Life Ready!*
