## **ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve Proposed New High School Course Emergency Medical Responder for 2023-2024.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) course will include comprehensive training in oxygen therapy and delivery, essential airway adjuncts, positive pressure ventilation, bleeding control, extremity splinting, and spinal immobilization. Upon completion of this course with a grade of a "C" or better, students may be able to receive a certificate of completion and are eligible to apply for an EMR certification through the state of California.

This course is for Grades 11 and 12 and is one semester in length.
