The Governing Board recognizes its obligations under <u>state and federal and state law</u> to <u>locate</u>, identify, <u>evaluate</u>, and provide equitable services to children voluntarily enrolled by their parents/guardians in private schools located within the district.

The Superintendent Chief Learning Officer or designee shall ensure that activities to locate, identify, and evaluate children with disabilities enrolled by their parents/guardians in private schools within the district are comparable to activities undertaken for individuals with disabilities aged three to 22 in public schools within the district. (34 CFR 300.131; (Education Code 56171)

The Superintendent Chief Learning Officer or designee shall develop a budget for the provision of services to children with disabilities enrolled by their parents/guardians in private school based on the proportionate share of federal funds received and the number of eligible children, including the possibility of mid-year enrollees, and the types of services to be provided.
