BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The academic achievement of students is the top priority of the education system in California. California Education Code sections 41507, 41572, and 64001 and the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) require each school to consolidate all school plans for programs funded through federal and state money.

The School Plans for Student Achievement align with the following Tahoe Truckee Unified School District Beliefs:

- 2. A culture of accountability shall drive excellence and promote the district vision of teaching and learning.

The SPSA process at each school involves the School Site Council's reviewing student achievement data, setting goals and writing action plans to improve educational outcomes for

students. Each school's English Learner Advisory Committee also reviews and advises each school on the development of the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA). SPSA goals are aligned with the district's LCAP goals and priorities.
