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**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Ratify Placer County School Based Mental Health Services Agreement for 2022-2024.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The mental health needs of our students have grown over the last several years. During this time, we contracted with the Placer County Behavior Health Department (PCBH) to provide enhanced mental health services for our students and their families who reside in Placer County. These services include mental health treatment, wellness, personal resiliency, and self-advocacy/empowerment. PCBH collaborates directly with our school counselors, school psychologists, school staff, wellness staff, and administration to provide a seamless system of care for our students. The PCBH staff are mental health clinicians with a valid mental health license. These clinicians are directly supervised by PCBH in collaboration with the TTUSD Student Services Department.

As part of our partnership with PCBH, the district contributes \$25,000 each year as a fiscal match with PCBH. TTUSD will contribute \$25,000 per year (\$50,000 for a two-year term) to provide mental health services for our students and families residing in Placer County.

Medi-Cal Billing Funds - \$25,000 per year.
