SUBJECT: First Read of Proposed Revisions to Board Policy 6143 and Administrative Regulation 6143, Course of Study

ACTION REQUESTED

First Read of proposed revisions to Board Policy and Administrative Regulation 6143, Course of Study.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Policy has been updated to expand the list of characteristics the district may not, based on the student's actual or perceived characteristic, provide any course separately or require or refuse participation by any student to more closely align with the law.

Regulation updated to reflect NEW LAW (AB 1078, 2023) which (1) includes people of all genders (formerly "men and women"), Latino Americans (formerly "Mexican Americans"), LGBTQ+ Americans (formerly "lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender Americans"), and members of other ethnic, cultural, religious, and socioeconomic status groups (formerly "ethnic and cultural") to the groups for which instruction in social studies is required to include a study of the role and contributions of.

The regulation was also updated to reflect the requirement for districts that offer a health education course to middle or high school students to include mental health instruction.
