What Is the California School Dashboard?

The California School Dashboard (or the Dashboard) is an online tool that shows parents and communities how well schools and districts are meeting the needs of all students. It reports performance on both state and local measures. These multiple measures reflect California's accountability system.

How Is Performance Measured?

Performance on the state measures is based on results for both the current and prior years.

For each state measure, schools and districts receive one of five performance levels. Each performance level is identified by a different color.

Performance Colors	Performance Levels
Blue (Highest Performance)	Very High
Green	High
Yellow	Medium
Orange	Low
Red (Lowest Performance)	Very Low



How Is Performance Reported on the Dashboard?


On the Dashboard reports, the performance levels appear as semi-circle gauges that are divided into color segments: red, orange, yellow, green, and blue. An arrow points to the color that represents the performance level for that measure.











TTUSD Academic Engagement:

Chronic Absenteeism: Reduced by 50%, which supports many other dashboard areas.








TTUSD Condition and Climate:






TTUSD Growth:
