CalSTRS Request for Separation from Service Requirement Exemption for Michael Depew

WHEREAS, the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (“District”) has an urgent need to obtain new substitutes for its students; and

WHEREAS CalSTRS retired member who has reached normal retirement age and is hired to fill a critically needed position during the first 180 calendar days following the member’s most recent retirement date, the retired member may request an exemption from the separation-from-service requirement, also known as the zero-dollar earnings limit; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT The Board of Education hereby intends to seek an exemption for Michael Depew, who has expressed interest in substituting for the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District.
