## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The 2022 TTUSD summer program included incoming kindergarten students, elementary school students, and high students who wanted to recover credit.

The elementary Power Summer program participants were selected based on academic need, and priority was given to English Learners and economically disadvantaged students. This year's program served 150 elementary students and was designed to provide an enriching and fun summer camp experience alongside small group tutoring.

The high school credit recovery program served 107 high school students, and 37-semester credits were recovered.

The presentation will review the 2022 summer program structure, the results, what worked well, and what changes will be considered for future summer programs.
