ACTION REQUESTED

First Read of the proposed revisions to Board Policy 6154, Homework/Makeup Work.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The policy has been updated to add that meaningful homework can provide enrichment and address student use of technology, including artificial intelligence, related to homework and makeup work.

Teacher training may include designing homework assignments that inspire students' interests, including that students may work with other students and use approved outside resources as directed by the teacher and move material related to notifying the student's parents/guardians when a student repeatedly fails to complete homework so that it follows chronologically.
