## **ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve proposed revisions to Board Policy 6142.5 Environmental Education.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The following changes are being made to Board Policy 6142.5 Environmental Education:

- Updated to reflect law which requires that the state-adopted environmental principles and concepts be integrated into content standards, curriculum frameworks, and textbook criteria.
- Reflects legislative intent that governing boards undertake specified actions to promote instruction in environmental literacy, including:
  - Embedding environmental literacy in the local priorities addressed in the district's local control and accountability plan,
  - Collaborating with other agencies to enhance the environmental curriculum,
  - o Providing professional development in environmental literacy, and
  - Ensuring equity in the provision of environment-based learning opportunities.
