

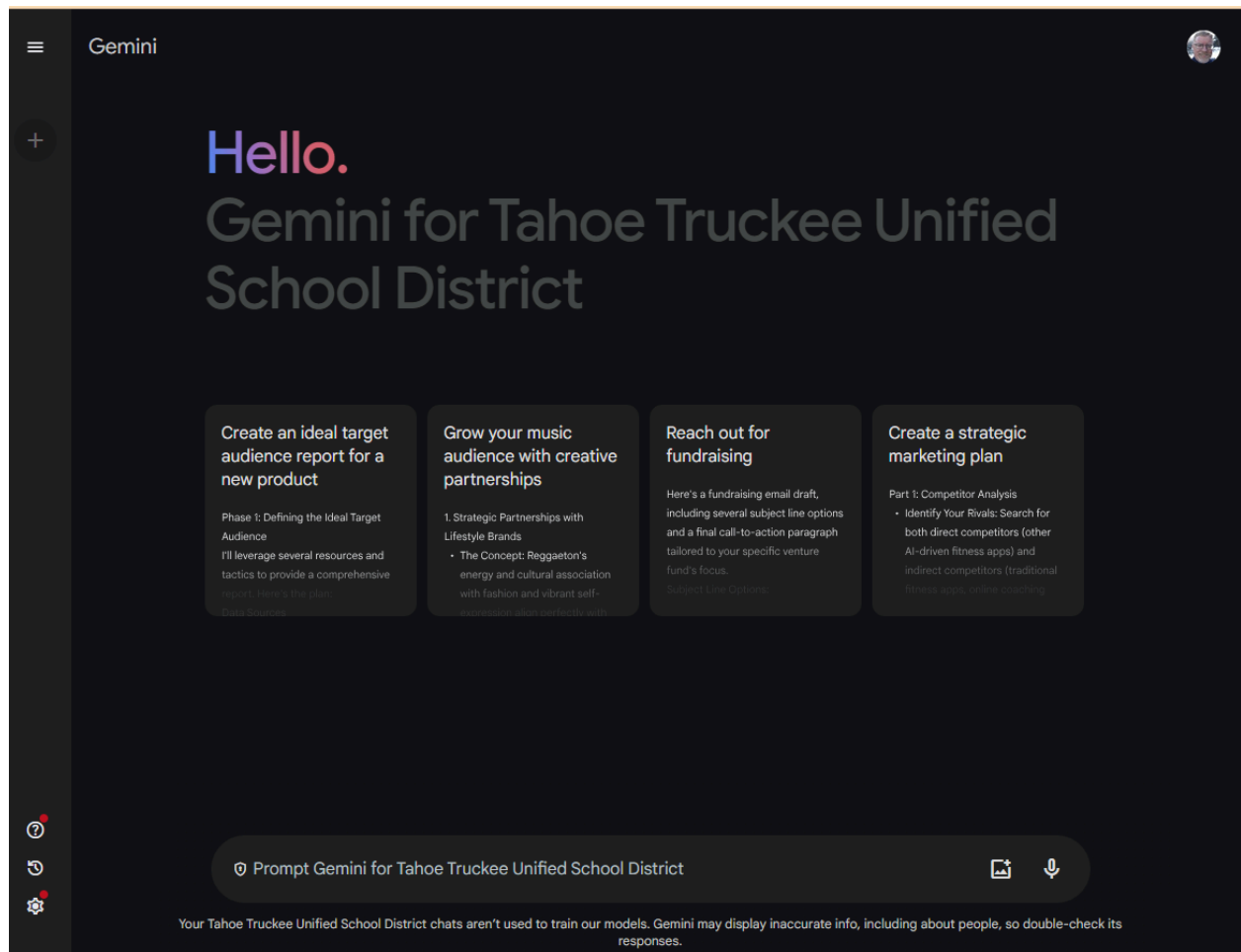

Why Google Gemini rather than Chat GPT

1. Access to Real-time Information: Gemini, by being connected to Google Search, has an advantage in providing up-to-date information compared to ChatGPT , whose knowledge base has a specific cutoff date.
2. Gemini has access to Google web storage to validate information and give web pages to verify information.
3. Chat history can be saved directly to a Google Doc to document conversations.
4. Gemini is designed to be used as a work support system. For Example: ChatGPT may be preferred for its more creative and engaging writing style, while Gemini might be favored for its concise and informative responses.
5. Understanding Complex Queries: Gemini may have the potential to better understand and dissect complex questions or prompts due to its integration with Google Search. This could mean more nuanced and helpful answers to intricate requests.

AI Usage Guidelines

- AI is a tool to enhance teaching, not to replace teaching
- AI should assist in tasks, but not replace instructional judgment; teachers know what instruction is best.
- AI use should Align with Educational Goals
- AI can be biased, misinformed and “Hallucinate Facts”
- AI platforms will be vetted by the District Technology team for compliance
- AI can be used to promote fairness, inclusivity and diversity
- Never provide identifying data about students or families to an AI platform
- Be accountable for the use of AI; cite the use of AI
- Teachers must remain actively engaged in the teaching and learning process.

Benefits and Risks of AI

AI Benefits

- improving equity, since more students can have access to personalized learning, tutoring strategies, and scaffolding;
- saving time, e.g., when brainstorming or troubleshooting;
- motivating learners when they feel stuck or unsure of how to move forward with a certain task
- developing certain critical thinking skills.

AI Risks

- it is based on a Natural Language Learning Model and will make things up to make the language sound correct. (Hallucination of Facts)
- Bard and Gemini use the Web but still make mistakes for fact checking.
- natural Language Learning Model does not use critical thinking. That is the human's job
- AI platforms have bias. They have trained on data sets that contain worldview and assumptions and will replicate those.
- AI apps depersonalize your writing. Overreliance may lead to a lack of voice and style.
- consider Data privacy when sharing information with an AI

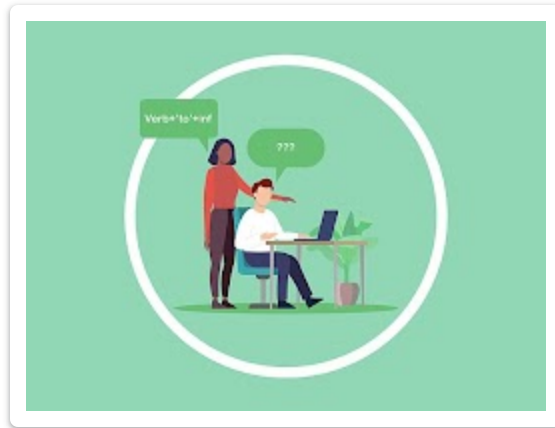

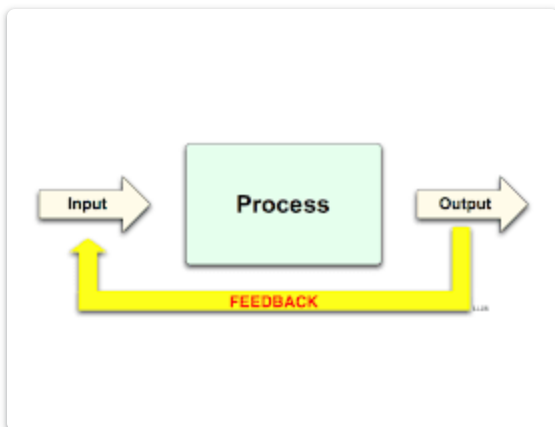
