ACTION REQUESTED

Review and Approve the Measure U Citizens' Oversight Committee 2018-2019, 2019-2020, and 2020-2021 Combined Annual Report

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On November 14, 2014, voters in the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District passed Measure U, a \$114 million school general obligation bond. Under the provisions of the California Constitution as amended by Proposition 39, an independent Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC) must be established to assure that the 2014 Measure U Bond funds are expended as approved by voters. As part of these duties, the COC must present an Annual Report to the Board of Trustees. This report should include at a minimum, the annual activities of the COC, information on bond expenditures and the annual performance audit, and a statement from the COC confirming that Measure U Bond funds were spent appropriately.

Matthew Hippler, the Measure U COC Chair, will present the 2014 Measure U Bond COC Annual Report. This report covers bond expenditures and COC activities that occurred during the 2018-2019, 2019-2020, and 2020-2021 fiscal years only.
