## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

On January 1, 2014, the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) System was established. The primary purpose of the CAASPP System is to assist teachers, administrators, students, and parents by promoting high-quality teaching and learning through various assessment approaches and item types. The test results are just one measurement to evaluate how our students are doing in grade 3-8 and grades 11. The results help identify where students are doing well or where they need more support. This information helps teachers better plan teaching and learning in the classroom, and is shared with families to bridge the learning needs at home.

Last spring, TTUSD students in grades 3 - 8 and 11 took the CAASPP tests for English Language Arts (ELA) and Math. In addition, every year, all TTUSD English Learners take the English Language Proficiency Assessment of CA (ELPAC). This presentation provides an overview of how TTUSD students performed on the ELA/Math CAASPP, and ELPAC in the 2022-2023 school year.
