BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Providing our students and staff in TTUSD Schools with a safe educational environment remains one of our top priorities. We are all aware of incidents of gun violence in our surrounding communities, and across the nation. A recent survey found that 57 percent of teens are concerned that there will be a shooting in their school.

Unsecured guns in the home pose a risk to students beyond gun violence in schools. Every year, nearly 350 children under the age of 18 <u>unintentionally shoot</u> themselves or someone else. That's roughly one unintentional shooting per day. Almost 1200 children die by gun suicide each year, and firearm suicide accounts for 50% of the firearm deaths in the state of California. In the overwhelming majority of these incidents, the gun used was one that belonged to someone in their home.
