This club was started years ago at North Tahoe Middle School and it's leaders spread it throughout schools in the Truckee/North Tahoe area. The club has not been active for several years. We are excited to start the club up but realize we are starting with zero funds. The club targets students to help empower them to pursue higher education, build up strong personal traits like confidence and positive self-talk. A large aspect of the club would be exposure to college tours and activities that promote health. We are requesting these funds for a college tour and compensation for a yoga instructor to come in and give a short class to the students. Because this was our first year back rolling out the club, we were going to start small with a field trip to UNR, however we found out that the 5th grade students would already be going to UNR with their class. The assistant principal advised that we go somewhere further like an overnight trip to either Sac State or Santa Cruz. This grant would directly support the cost of these trips and activities.
