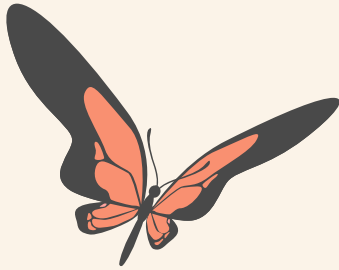

# ELO-P MOU 2024-2025



- Formal partnership with a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
  - Total of \$1,040,858.00 from the ELO-P grant
  - Comprehensive and seamless ASES/ELO-P program
- BGCNLT staff provide programming, snacks/lunch and supper
  - TTUSD will provide lunch and snack during summer programs at TES
- Program locations:
  - Kings Beach Clubhouse (serving TK-6 students from multiple Lakeside Schools)
  - Truckee Elementary (serving TK-5 students from Truckee Side Schools)
  - Alder Creek Middle School (serving 6th grade students)

# ELO-P BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB NORTH LAKE TAHOE

- Summer Program Date: July 1-August 2, 2024
  - 9 Hour day
- BGCNLT recognized by CDE for their rigorous program, meeting all standards of excellence for before and after school programs.
- TTUSD provides transportation in the morning and early afternoon (2:30 p.m.) serving both Truckee and Lakeside families
- Highly Qualified Camp Counselors
- Students by age rotate through
  - STEAM Enrichment activities
  - Outdoor learning and recreation opportunities
  - Field Trips
  - Sports and team building activities

# 2023 ELOP SUMMER DATA

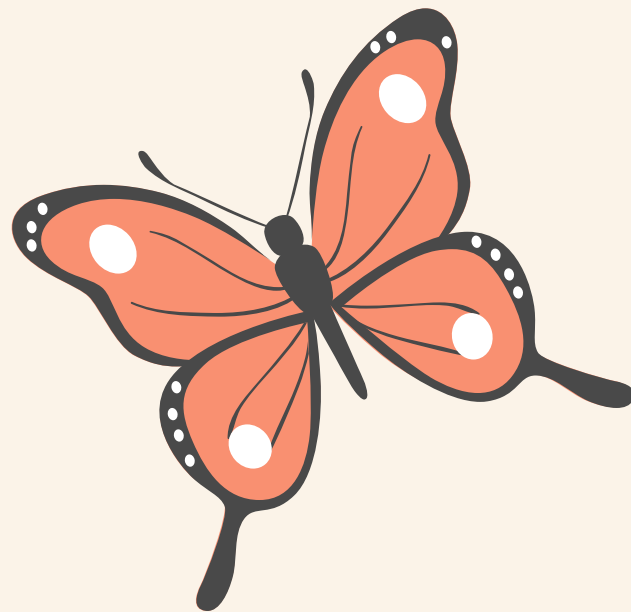


- TES - 160 students participated through the ELOP grant
- KBE - 182 students participated through the ELOP grant
- Throughout the summer program, 3,840 meals were provided to students through the ELOP grant at KBE.

# SUMMER PROGRAM CURRENT STATISTICS

## 2024 ELO-P Summer Program

- KBE Total Enrolled as of 3/25/24:
  - 160 students enrolled
- TES Total Enrolled as of 3/25/24:
  - 155 students enrolled



# AIM HIGH

- Summer Program Date: July 1-August 2, 2024
  - 9 Hour day
- TTUSD partnership with Aim High serves our rising 6-9th grade students
- Aim High summer priorities:
  - Three Project-Based Learning Courses
  - Social-Emotional Learning
  - Enrichment Activities
  - College and Career Preparation lead by Aim High staff and alumni
  - Culture & Teaching is grounded in Restorative Practices
- Advisory
- Field Trips
- Cultural Days and Special Events
- Academic Choices: Humanities, Issues and Choices, STEM Challenge



# 2023 AIM HIGH SUMMER DATA



- 64 students were served
- 6 schools were represented
- 85% of students qualified for Free and Reduced Lunch

# CREDIT RECOVERY

- Blended summer school credit recovery option for TTUSD 9-12 students.
- Credit Recovery is offered both in-person and virtual learning through the online Edgenuity learning platform. This model provides a supportive, and effective way for TTUSD students to recover credits and get back on track with their education.
- THS, NTHS, and SHS students enrolled in CR.
- CR is proctored by credentialed Math and English teachers.
- Students who attend in-person classes have the opportunity to work with credentialed teacher up to 4 hours a day.
- Students who choose virtual learning meet with teachers on a weekly basis for guidance and support.

# 2023 CREDIT RECOVERY SUMMER DATA



- 117 students enrolled
- 18 courses
- 54 courses completed for credit

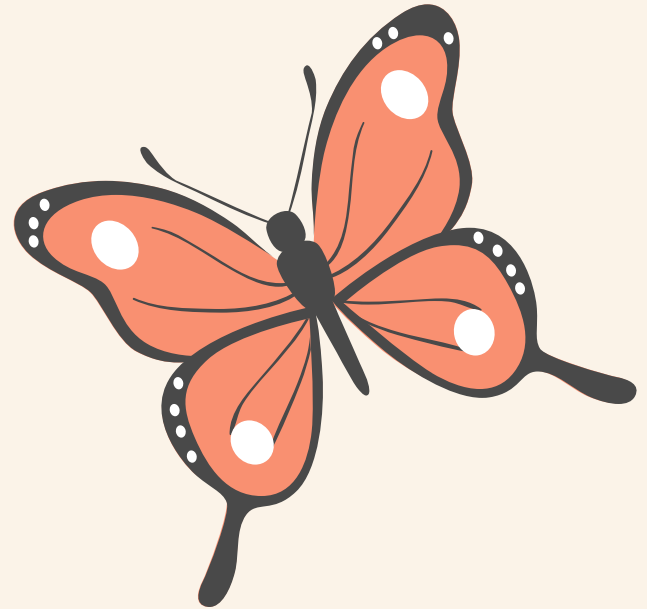
Current numbers before end of the semester:

# TK SUMMER BRIDGE

- A 10-day, half day program from July 15-26, 2024.
- Focus on activities and learning opportunities. Introducing TK learners to early skills such as basic literacy, numeracy, and fine motor skills development.
- TK Bridge places a strong emphasis on social-emotional learning opportunities, as well as play-based learning.
- TK Bridge is designed to provide students with an introduction to TK skills and foster a love of learning.

# 2023 TK BRIDGE SUMMER DATA



- Served 19 students at TES
- All students bridged to TK and K
- Served our CSPP program and Head Start Program
